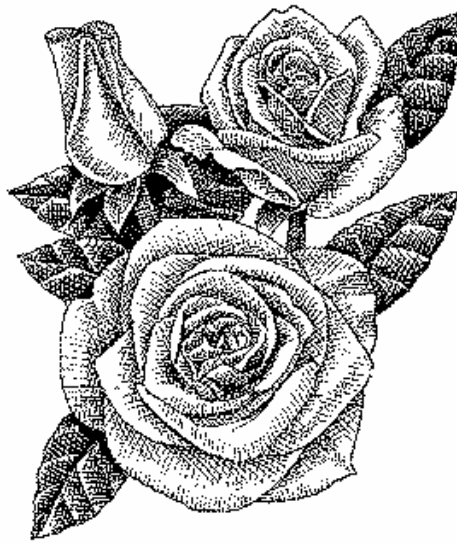

Tender Roses

Tender Roses are grown for their outstanding flowering capabilities. We do not guarantee them to overwinter, but many people have had success with special protection as noted below.

Planting and Watering:

Roses require 6-8 hours of sunlight daily. Plant the graft of the rose below soil level about 4-6". Leave a depression around the base of the plant and water well. Water daily until new growth appears and every other day after that. Use Root Booster when planting and a rose fertilizer (18-24-16) after that. Fill the depression in with soil throughout the year.

Winter Protection:

In fall, give plants a good soaking just before freeze up. Cover with 12-18" of mulch (peat moss or straw). Cover stems with snow to prevent repeated thawing and freezing. In spring, uncover the roses when the tree buds begin to swell. Prune off any branch tips that have died over winter.

Hardy Roses

At Lakeshore Garden Centre, we carry over 25 varieties of hardy roses. These roses can survive our cold winters with little to no protection.

When buying a rose it is important to consider color, size and location. Roses like about 4-6 hours of sunlight per day. We recommend planting the rose 3-4" deeper than it is in the pot. When planting roses make sure that the hole is twice as big as the pot. Use a mixture of 1/3 peat moss and 2/3 topsoil when planting, this ensures that the roots of the plant will be able to spread more easily. We also recommend using a transplant fertilizer such as Root Booster. This enables the plant to root more quickly, thus increasing the rose's ability to adapt to the environment.

Newly planted roses need to be watered every day as the young roots dry out quickly. In fall make sure you water your roses regularly in order to provide moisture for the winter. If you choose to cover your roses, 6-8" of mulch (grass clippings, peat moss, leaves) should be sufficient.

In spring, cut all roses (except Persian Yellow) about 6" from the ground. This enables new young branches to form and keep the rose thick. Persian Yellow needs to be pruned after it has bloomed as it only blooms on second year stems. Prune off roses after they have finished blooming until the middle of August. This will allow rose hips to set for the fall and winter.
