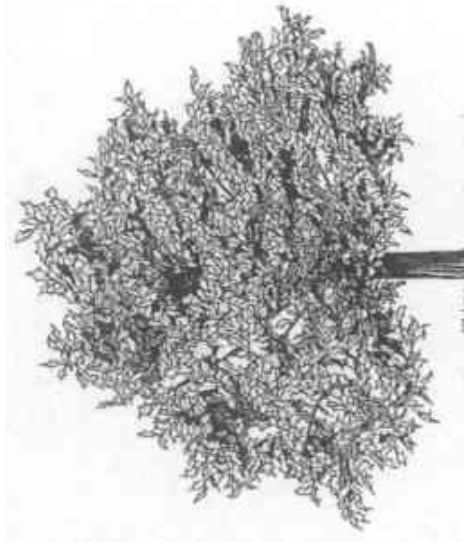

Hawthorn	Fragrant flowers, green glossy foliage and colorful fruit. Prefers well-drained soil. A great tree for a small yard.

Linden	Tiny, fragrant yellow flowers in summer & heart-shaped leaves. A clean, low maintenance tree.

Dropmore	10m (30')	7m (21')	Yellow		Yellow	Slow growing with a dense pyramidal shape. Hybrid cross between American and Littleleaf lindens. A clean, low maintenance tree.

Maple	Each maple is unique – great fall color. Very adaptable trees. Prune only after it is in full leaf.

Mountain Ash	Ornamental tree with white flowers, fern-like foliage and bright orange-red berries in late summer. Plant in well-drained soil.

Showy	7m (20')	5m (15')	White	Red	Red	Compact variety. Blooms longer than other mountain ash. Very hardy. Moderate resistance to fire blight.

Poplar	Fast growing, adaptable trees. Do not produce cotton or sticky seeds. Great for shelterbelts, acreages or large spaces.					
Assiniboine	15m (45')	5m (15')			Yellow	Semi-upright form. Deep green foliage.
Swedish Aspen	10m (30')	2m (6')			Yellow-orange	Columnar growth habit. Circular, dark green leaves with wavy edges. Excellent screen.
Willow	Fast growing trees with arching branches.					
Laurel-Leaf	12m (36')	10m (30')			Yellow	Glossy green leaves. Furrowed bark. Excellent for large spaces. Extremely hardy.
Silver	10m (30')	8m (25')				Rapid growing with silver leaves. Arching golden branches provide a weeping effect. Older bark is dark grayish-brown and ridged.
